Frequently asked questions

What is the MOQ for sourcing from Kenya & Ghana?

MOQs vary by craft and supplier — typical bulk MOQs start at 30–200 units (or 5 m² for tiles). Sample orders at 1–5 units are often available.

What are typical lead times from Kenya & Ghana?

Most Kenya & Ghana bulk orders ship in 4–8 weeks ex-works, plus 2–4 weeks for sea freight. Repeats run faster.

Do Kenya & Ghana suppliers offer OEM / private label?

Yes — most verified suppliers offer OEM and private-label production with custom shapes, finishes, and packaging. OEM minimums are typically 200+ units.
