## Frequently asked questions

---

### **What is the MOQ for sourcing from Mexico?**

MOQs vary by craft and supplier — typical bulk MOQs start at 30–200 units (or 5 m<sup>2</sup> for tiles). Sample orders at 1–5 units are often available.

### **What are typical lead times from Mexico?**

Most Mexico bulk orders ship in 4–8 weeks ex-works, plus 2–4 weeks for sea freight. Repeats run faster.

### **Do Mexico suppliers offer OEM / private label?**

Yes — most verified suppliers offer OEM and private-label production with custom shapes, finishes, and packaging. OEM minimums are typically 200+ units.
